Tire Amnesty will be held in Carroll County on June 23, 24, and 25.

The county's contract with Rumpke ends in July, due to a 60 day contract extension. Mr. Marsh is looking over the contract at this time.

Painting is complete at the Hall of Justice and parking lot resurfacing will be done this weekend.

The section of the CCMH parking lot located near the health department is in need of more work than first realized. To completely blacktop that area would increase the overall project cost to repair and seal the parking lot by \$10,000.00. Magistrate Miller made a motion to approve.
