# <u>Grant – Courthouse Square</u>

Carroll County has been approved for a streetscape grant in the amount of \$186,622 for improvements around the courthouse square. No action taken.

#### **Emergency Watershed Project**

A federal project through the Natural Resources Conservation Service is available to assist with installation of emergency watershed protection measures as a result of the August storm event in the amount of \$255,950. Current areas listed in the project are East and West Prong Locust and Millcreek. Judge Tomlinson is attempting to add Notch Lick, Bucks Run area and the Worthville area to the project. Magistrate Bowling made a motion to enter into the agreement. Magistrate Miller 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.

- The KY River Bridge at Prestonville will have intermittent 10-15 minute closures on Thursday for surveying. In case of bad weather, the closures will be on Friday.
- Hwy 36 resurfacing and striping is complete.
- Guardrails should be installed on Whites Run by the end of the month.
- The court agreed to purchase a bed for a road department truck for \$2500. Road Supervisor is checking on installation.
- Resurfacing of Hwy 42/Highland Avenue is scheduled for the end of September. No action taken.

#### County Judge's Comments

- The Champions group has a drug disposal box available at the Police Department for anyone needing to properly dispose of unneeded drugs.
- Arkema will be hosting the household hazardous waste and electronic equipment recycling 9/18 and 9/19.
- Business Appreciation Day is 09/17 from 5-7 p.m. on the courthouse square.
- Coroner David Willhoite requested to purchase a mortuary cot for \$2000-\$3000.
