The Judge has become aware of a grant opportunity to possibly help offset the county's portion of the heating and cooling upgrades at the courthouse.

There is also a grant opportunity to possibly fund more sewer lines in the county. The court was in favor of allowing the Judge to pursue these grants.

The county may be able to bid out three additional watershed projects.

Judge Tomlinson showed the court members a listing of road needs that have been prioritized.

The road department responded to a damaged bridge in Owen County recently. An invoice for the work has been submitted to the insurance carrier of the driver of the vehicle that hit the bridge for reimbursement.

Swearing in ceremony for newly elected officials will be December 27 at 7 p.m.

The Fiscal Court meeting in December will be held December 15 with the employee Christmas dinner to follow.
