

**REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ)  
CARROLL COUNTY FISCAL COURT  
COURTHOUSE AREA STREETScape PROJECT**

The Carroll County Fiscal Court will accept qualifications from consulting engineering firms for planning, design, construction and other required professional services relating to the Courthouse Area Streetscape Project.

The project is being funded by the Transportation Enhancement Program through the Transportation Equity Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century (TEA-21) and the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU), in cooperation with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet.

Attention of all respondents is particularly called to the following regulations and requirements; Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA); and the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program, as described in 23 CFR 635 Subpart A and Section 1101(b) of SAFETEA-LU. **Minority firms are encouraged to submit.**

Engineering services/activities will include at a minimum, but not be limited to, the following phases: Preliminary/final design; Advertising/Bid; Construction administration, oversight, and inspection.

The Carroll County Fiscal Court reserves the right to reject any and all responses, to waive any technicalities and to negotiate with respondent who most nearly meets the project requirements. The Fiscal Court is not responsible or liable for any costs incurred by consultants replying to this request.
